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1SEC. 2. ALLOWING PHYSICAL THERAPISTS TO UTILIZE2LOCUM TENENS ARRANGEMENTS UNDER3MEDICARE.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The first sentence of section 5 1842(b)(6) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395u(b)(6)) is amended by striking ", and (J)" and all 6 that follows through "physicians' services furnished by 7 physicians." and inserting ", and (J) in the case of out-8 patient physical therapy services furnished by physical 9 therapists, subparagraph (D) of this sentence shall apply 10 11 to such services and therapists in the same manner as such subparagraph applies to physicians' services fur-12 nished by physicians.". 13

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
subsection (a) shall apply to items and services furnished
after the date of the enactment of this Act.
